Ten of the clues are **Printer's Devilries**, clues from which from which a hidden answer has been removed, as in the following example.

Clue: Where's smoke? There's fire!
 Answer: **ETHER** — Where **there**'s smoke, there's fire.

The clue's punctuation and spacing are not to be trusted; however, its letters do appear in their proper order. And to make things slightly easier, each clue contains some allusion to its missing answer. The remaining ten clues are otherwise unremarkable.
