Get onto the North-South highway, take the Sungai Buloh exit. Turn left immediately after the toll, heading West towards Kuala Selangor on B54. Park on the right-hand side of the **main road** immediately after that right turn, behind the "Ladang Tuan Mee" sign. Mind the traffic.
