I would like to begin with saying that if you did not attend the meeting then please hold you complaints until the next meeting. Here are some things that we discussed:

- > If you only have 3 shooters for a match, the player with the highest spree can not shoot for the sub. The other 2 players must shoot for the sub. This rule applies to the Wednesday Night Open League only.
- > In order for me to provide a Newsletter that contains information about each league then I will need your help. If something happens you think could make a good article in a newsletter then write it down and put it in the envelope. This "gossip" will be edited to protect the welfare of the innocent.
- > The Wednesday night "D" league will be in divisions according to prior sprees depending on the number of teams.
- > The upcoming season will start the week of September 10<sup>th</sup> and end around the second week of February. The next season will begin the first week of March and will be ending the second week of July. This will allow you to have Most of July, all of August and Some of September off.
